

FROM THE DMV 11-2017

REGISTRATION, TITLE, and TRIP PERMIT FEE INCREASES • The 2017 Legislature authorized an increase in DMV fees effective January 1, 2018.

HB 2017 increases most registration, light vehicle title, and light vehicle and RV trip permit fees. Fees are listed in Chapter M, Fees, of the Title and Registration Handbook.

Registration Fees:

Passenger: Passenger registration fees are increasing by \$13 per year of registration. Passenger vehicles are eligible for 1-, 2- or 4-year registration.

Passenger vehicles powered solely by electricity are not subject to the additional registration fee if enrolled in the OReGO (pay-per-mile) program at the time of registration or renewal. The registration fee charged will be based on the OReGO status at the time of registration or renewal.

- Not enrolled in OReGO at time of initial registration or renewal: If a customer registers or renews their electric vehicle and enrolls in OReGO after the fact, they do not get a refund of the additional registration fees. They will pay the lesser registration fee at the next renewal.
- Enrolled in OReGO at time of initial registration or renewal: If a customer's electric vehicle is enrolled in OReGO at the time of registration or renewal they will pay the lower fee. If the customer deactivates their participation in OReGO after the fact, they do not need to pay the additional registration fee until their next renewal.

The fee charged to rental companies when they register brand new vehicles for 1 or 2 years instead of 4 years is increasing from \$1 to \$2 per vehicle.

Light/Utility Trailers: Light/utility trailer registration fees are increasing by \$15 per year of registration. Light/utility trailers are eligible for 2- or 4-year registration.

Motorcycles/Mopeds: Registration fees for non-electric and non-hybrid motorcycles are increasing by \$15 per year of registration. Registration fees for electric and hybrid motorcycles and mopeds are increasing by \$17.50 per year of registration. HB 2017 aligned the registration periods for hybrid and electric motorcycles and mopeds with all other powered motorcycles and mopeds. All motorcycles and mopeds are eligible for 2- or 4-year registration regardless of motive power.

Motor Homes: The registration fee for 6- to 14-foot motor homes is increasing from \$54 to \$86. Motor home fees are for a 2-year registration period only. Registration fees for motor homes over 14 feet are not changing.

Electric and hybrid motor homes will no longer pay an additional 50% of the registration fee. Registration fees for electric or hybrid motor homes will be the same as motor homes with other motive powers.

Commercial Buses, Trucks: Registration fees for commercial trucks and buses registered quarterly are increasing for vehicles weighing 8,000 pounds or less, up to 26,000 pounds. Registration fees for these vehicles registered at weights of 26,001 pounds or more are not changing. The additional fee charged for vehicles that register quarterly for less than 4 quarters is increasing from \$1 to \$2.

Electric and hybrid commercial trucks and buses will no longer pay an additional 50% of the registration fee. Registration fees for these vehicles that are electric or hybrid will be the same as comparable vehicles with other motive powers.

Tow Vehicles: Registration fees for tow vehicles certified under ORS 822.205 weighing up to 26,000 pounds are increasing. Tow vehicles 8,000 pounds or less pay the passenger registration fee. All tow vehicles certified under ORS 822.205 pay an additional \$17 tow business certificate fee.

Charitable/Non-Profit: Registration fees for vehicles registered quarterly as charitable/non-profit are increasing for all weight ranges. Vehicles 8,000 pounds or less cannot be registered as charitable/non-profit. The additional fee charged for vehicles that register quarterly for less than 4 quarters is increasing from \$1 to \$2.

Manufactured Structure Toters: Registration fees for manufactured structure toters are increasing for all weight ranges. Vehicles 8,000 pounds or less cannot be registered as manufactured structure toters. The additional fee charged for vehicles that register quarterly for less than 4 quarters is increasing from \$1 to \$2.

Farm Vehicles: Registration fees for vehicles registered as farm vehicles are increasing for all weight ranges. The additional fee charged for vehicles that register quarterly for less than 4 quarters is increasing from \$1 to \$2.

Electric and hybrid farm vehicles will no longer pay an additional 50% of the registration fee. Registration fees for these vehicles that are electric or hybrid will be the same as comparable vehicles with other motive powers.

Special Use Trailers: Registration fees for special use trailers are increasing to align with the registration fees for recreational trailers and campers (\$81.00 + \$6.75 per foot). Special use trailers are registered by length for 2 years.

For-Rent Trailers: Registration fees for for-rent trailers are increasing by \$3 per year of registration. For-rent trailers are eligible for 1- or 5-year registration.

Fleet Vehicles: The fleet vehicle service fee is increasing by \$1 per vehicle.

Other Vehicles Registered for 2 Years: Registration fees for other vehicles registered for 2 years are increasing.

Permanently Registered Vehicles: Registration fees for some permanently registered vehicles are increasing. The school bus registration fee is decreasing to align with other permanently-registered government vehicles.

Title Fees:

Light vehicle title fees are increasing by \$16. Customers who submit an application for a light vehicle title on or after January 1, 2018, will pay the new fee. The heavy vehicle and salvage title fees are not changing.

Trip Permit Fees:

The fees for light vehicle trip permits and recreational vehicle trip permits are increasing by \$2 from \$30 to \$32 per permit. All other trip permit fees are staying the same.

The trip permit fees will be removed from the trip permit forms due to future increases in 2020, 2022 and 2024. This will eliminate the need to recycle forms with outdated fees. The new trip permit forms will be distributed to DMV field offices, and will be sold to vehicle dealers and trip permit agents prior to January 1, 2018.
